Three-year courses are offered in agriculture, domestic science, and commerce, each leading to a certificate of graduation; four-year courses are offered in agriculture, domestic science, commerce, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, and general science, each leading to a degree. In addition, there are manual-training courses in domestic arts, three years, and mechanic arts, four years, each leading to a certificate of graduation; a college preparatory course, two years, and a subpreparatory course, one year; also winter courses in agriculture, domestic arts, and mechanic arts.
